

RULES ON TRAINING OF INTERNATIONAL TREC JUDGES

The quality of the training of judges is an essential part of the technical evaluation of our competitors and the credibility of our competitions.

To become « International judge » :

| Follow a training course in their NETO every 2 years. | Be national judge since 3 years. | Have judged at least three national events in the past 2 years. | |

The NETO must provide 1 certificate on which figure:

The place, date and name of the course instructor,

The number of events considered in specifying the place, date and name of the President of the Jury for each event.

The NETO send the complete file to the FITE who investigates and decides on its validation.

To become « Trainer of International Judges » :

| Formation | Expérience | Jugement |
|---|---------------------------------------|---|
| Follow a training course certified by the FITE every 2 years. | Be international judge since 3 years. | Have judged at least 2 national events and 1 international event in the past 2 years. |

The NETO must provide 2 certificates:

One for the training : indicating the place, date and name of the course instructor, One for the number of events judged indicating the place, date and name of the President of the Jury for each event.

The NETO send the complete file to the FITE who investigates and decides on its validation.

In the Championships, only judges nominated by their NETO will officer.
